Tess has been a member of Les Grands Ballets Canadiens de Montreal, Gothenburg Opera Ballet, and held a permanent position with the Cullberg Ballet in Stockholm. She is the 2019 recipient of the Birgit Cullberg Stipendiat for her work presenting experimental dance in rural areas.
